Exhibitions

We consider contemporary art to be a tool for researching and interpreting various ideas. Artists can use their imagination, intuition, sensitivity and discipline to capture the otherwise invisible or overlooked aspects of reality, placing them in a new light.

Performing arts

We present selected performances from the intersection of contemporary dance, theatre and visual arts. We organise performances, workshops and artist residencies, meetings with artists, lectures and screenings of films about performing arts.

Books

Publications by the Ujazdowski Castle Centre for Contemporary Art, invariably created in cooperation with outstanding graphic artists, are distinguished by their quality content, outstanding editorial level and highly original form. The publishing programme includes occasional prints connected with exhibitions and other *U-jazdowski* events, as well as classical publications – books about art and artists, including unquestionable rarities: works by the artists themselves. Publications accompanying exhibitions take various forms – from small guides, used as an introduction to an event, through more or less extensive catalogues, to art books – which are sometimes an event in their own right.

Library and reading room

The library and reading room are located in the arcades of Ujazdowski Castle's courtyard. The collection includes exhibition catalogues, monographs of artists and academic publications on art and culture, as well as a rich selection of Polish and foreign art magazines.

Bookshop

The bookshop offers books about contemporary art and artists, collections of essays and catalogues, as well as posters from exhibitions presented at Ujazdowski Castle.

Park

Ujazdowski Castle is located in a picturesque area, on the Vistula Escarpment, near Łazienki Park, Ujazdowski Park, and Jazdów Estate.
